Gettysburg Battlefield Bus Tour



Travel the historic fields of Gettysburg in the comfort of an air-conditioned guided tour bus and watch history come alive through the eyes of a licensed guide. Enjoy a truly unique

perspective into the three-day Battle of Gettysburg.

The guided two hour battlefield tour provides visitors with the



most thorough overview of the battle available in Gettysburg. All guided bus tours are conducted by guides licensed by the Gettysburg National Military Park.

Tour will begin with the bus leaving at 12:15pm from the Wyndham Gardens in York. A stop at the Gettysburg Tour Center for restrooms before continuing on for the Battlefield tour. The bus will return to the Gettysburg

Tour Center after the tour for another rest stop and will leave at 4:00PM to return to the hotel.



York County History Center and Colonial Complex Bus Tour



The York County History Center offers three museums, four historic sites and a genealogy research library all located within the City of York, PA. The museums cover history from our earliest roots through current day with an emphasis on topics such as colonial times, agriculture, manufacturing, firefighting and the decorative arts.

Uncover York County's key role in the Revolutionary War and immerse yourself in the vibrant culture of the 18th century during an engaging 45-60 minute guided tour. First up, the Golden Plough Tavern, standing proud since 1741, beckons you to experience colonial life firsthand. Next door is the General Horatio Gates House, where you can delve into the story of American General Horatio Gates and his pivotal stay during the winter of 1777-1778. Then step into the reconstructed Colonial Courthouse, where echoes of the Second Continental Congress and members' debate over the Articles of Confederation still linger. And finally, don't miss the Barnett Bobb Log House, a charming relic from 1812 relocated to the Colonial Complex.

Tour will begin with the bus leaving at 1:00PM from the Wyndham Gardens in York. Begin loading at 12:45pm.
