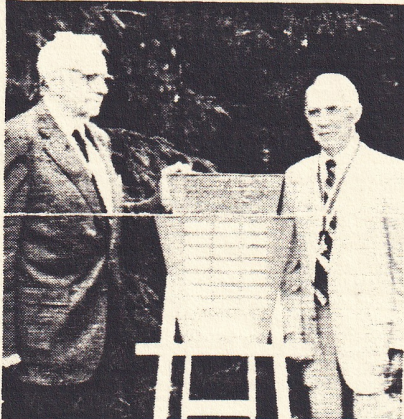

## JUDGE WOODSIDE TO ADDRESS CHAPTER ON SEPTEMBER 11

"Upper Dauphin County's Contribution to the American Revolution" will be the topic of Judge Robert E. Woodside, of Harrisburg, in addressing the quarterly dinner meeting of Harris Ferry Chapter, on Wednesday evening, September 11, in the upstairs Lounge Room of the NCAD Officers' Club, at New Cumberland Army Depot.

Judge Woodside, a proud native of Millersburg, as attested in his 1979 autobiography entitled "My Life and Town," has the distinction of having served in all three branches of State Government: Legislative (as a member of the General Assembly, 1932-42); Judicial (as Judge of the Dauphin County Court, 1942-51, and a Judge of the Superior Court of Pennsylvania, 1953-57), and the Executive Branch (as Attorney General of Pennsylvania, 1951-53).
