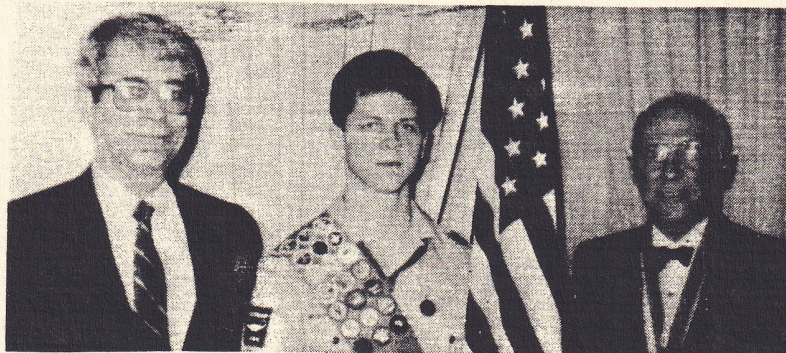
DR. HALL TO HEAD P.S.S.A.R.
