PROGRAM TO FEATURE SLIDES OF 1941 PEARL HARBOR RAID
THE 46TH ANNUAL MEETING OF HARRIS FERRY CHAPTER will be a dinner at the Harrisburg Country Club, at 6 p.m. on Sunday, December 7, which — appropriately enough — happens to be the 45th anniversary of the devastating Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor.

In recognition of that disastrous event in American history, a short slide presentation, based on Navy photographs of what occurred at Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, will be presented by LTC George E. Reed, secretary and past president of the chapter.
