SAR CHAPTER TO HONOR EAGLE SCOUT COMPETITION WINNER

Eagle Scout Joseph M. Walker, 15, of Mechanicsburg, a freshman at the Cumberland Valley High School, will be honored by Harris Ferry Chapter at the George Washington Dinner, as the area winner of the 1986 Eagle Scout Competition sponsored nationally by the SAR in cooperation with the Boy Scouts of America.



He will receive the SAR Good Citizenship Medal from Chapter President Oscar H. Stroh and Compatriot Ronald F. Walters, chairman of the Chapter's Eagle Scout Committee.

As winner among the year's 61 new Eagle Scouts of the Keystone Area Council of BSA, Walker is a contender for the statewide trophy of the Pennsylvania SAR, and a possible contender for the national prize of a \$2,000 scholarship.

He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph A. Walker, of 131 Simmons Road, Mechanicsburg, and a member of Scout Troop 195, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Mechanicsburg.
