MILITARY HISTORIAN TO ADDRESS DECEMBER 13th MEETING

"The History of Carlisle Barracks" will be the topic of Lt. Col. Martin W. Andresen, Deputy Director of the U.S. Army Military History Institute, at the chapter's 47th annual meeting, on Sunday evening, December 13, at Blue Mountain Inn, 2201 Fishing Creek Valley Road, north of Harrisburg.

A 1965 graduate and later a History professor at West Point, Colonel Andresen, has been stationed at Carlisle since 1982.

With the use of slides, he will trace the interesting 250-year history of Carlisle Barracks, as the second oldest military base in the United States.
