LTC George E. Reed, chapter secretary and past president, will speak on the Whig Convention of 1839, which met in Harrisburg's Zion Lutheran Church, to launch the campaign of "Tippecanoe and Tyler Too" (William Henry Harrison and John Tyler, his successor as President).
