ARMY EXPERT ON U.S.S.R. TO ADDRESS DECEMBER MEETING
 "Current Developments in Eastern Europe" will be the topic of LTC Michael H. Crutcher, director of Soviet Operations in the Center for Strategic Wargaming at the U.S. Army War College, in addressing the 49th Annual Dinner Meeting of Harris Ferry Chapter of SAR, on Sunday evening, December 17, at the Inn of Blue Mountain, in Fishing Creek Valley.

Colonel Crutcher, who has held his present position at Carlisle for the past 18 months, served for two years in Vietnam, following his graduation from UC-Davis, where he received his BA in History in 1967, and an MA in Political Science in 1968.
