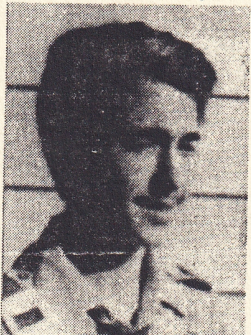
### FRANKLIN HISTORIAN TO ADDRESS WASHINGTON DINNER

"The Noble Chieftain and the Immortal Sage — Washington and Franklin" will be the topic of Dr. Whitfield J. Bell, of Carlisle, in addressing the Annual George Washington Dinner co-sponsored by DAR and SAR chapters of Harrisburg, Sunday evening, February 18, at the Harrisburg Country Club, near Fort Hunter.

### LOYSVILLE YOUTH WINNER OF EAGLE SCOUT CONTEST

Eagle Scout Clair A. Smith, Jr., of Loysville RD 2, a 9th grader at West Perry High School, is to be honored by Harris Ferry Chapter on February 18, as area winner of the 1989 Eagle Contest sponsored annually by SAR.

Smith attained the Eagle rank in December 1988, when he was 14, as a member of Troop No. 73.



This topic, honoring the memory of Benjamin Franklin as well as George Washington, is especially appropriate this year, with 1990 being observed nationally as the bi-centennial of Franklin's death in 1790 at the age of 84.

Dr. Bell, a former professor of History at Dickinson College and at William and Mary is a recognized authority on Franklin, having served on the editorial staff for the 1954-1961 publications of "The Benjamin Franklin Papers." Subsequently, Bell was for many years the librarian and executive director of The American Philosophical Society—positions once held by Franklin himself.
