STATE TO FLY 13-STAR FLAG

In observance of Flag Day, the State will again fly a 13-star flag from the main flag-pole atop the Capitol Building on June 14, as arranged by Harris Ferry Chapter.

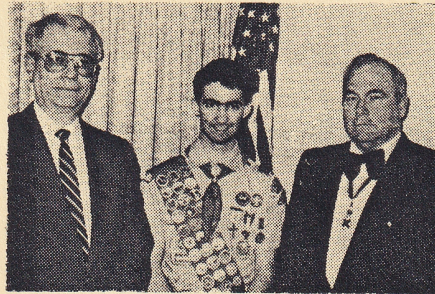
The 10-foot nylon flag was presented to the State three years ago by the chapter for such use annually on June 14 — which this year marks the 214th anniversary of the day in 1777 when the Second Continental Congress officially adopted the *Stars & Stripes*, as the national ensign.

25- AND 50-YEAR MEMBERS
