#### DESERT STORM OFFICER TO ADDRESS CHAPTER

Col. Robert Kee, of Plainfield, who served as American liaison with the French forces in the *Desert Storm* campaign, will be the guest speaker at the Chapter's Constitution Week Dinner, September 18 at the Carlisle Barracks Officers Club.

Colonel Kee was formerly staff assistant to the Supreme Allied Commander at NATO Headquarters, Europe.

A West Point graduate, he served for some years on the faculty there in the French Language Department. More recently, prior to his retirement from active duty, he was special assistant to the Commandant of the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle.
