CHAPTER HONORS 72 NEW EAGLES

Harris Ferry Chapter presented SAR Certificates of Recognition to the 72 new Eagle Scouts of the four-county Keystone Area, Tuesday evening, November 26, at the annual banquet of Keystone Area Council, B.S.A.

This was the chapter's ninth year of active participation in the Eagle Scout Program sponsored nationally by SAR. This chapter, since 1983, has awarded certificates to some 770 new Eagle Scouts of this area.

NEW MEMBER

Daniel Lee Mundorf, of 7 Pocono Dr., Mechanicsburg, approved by SAR August 12.

An updated history of the chapter, as prepared recently for inclusion in the 100-year history of the Pennsylvania Society of SAR, will be presented for discussion at the meeting.

Harris Ferry Chapter was formally instituted on May 9, 1940, at a meeting held at Zembo Mosque, with Judge John E. Fox, presiding, and a total of 119 charter members.

- o Election or re-election of Chapter Officers for '92.
