## YEAR MARKS THE 215th BIRTHDAY OF OUR FLAG

### STATE TO FLY 13-STAR FLAG

In observance of Flag Day, a 13-star American flag will be flown from the main flagpole atop the State Capitol Building here on Sunday, June 14.

The date this year marks the 215th anniversary of the official adoption of "the stars and stripes" as our nation's ensign by the Continental Congress at Philadelphia in 1777.

The 10-foot nylon flag is one presented to the Commonwealth by Harris Ferry Chapter, in 1988 for such use annually on Flag Day.

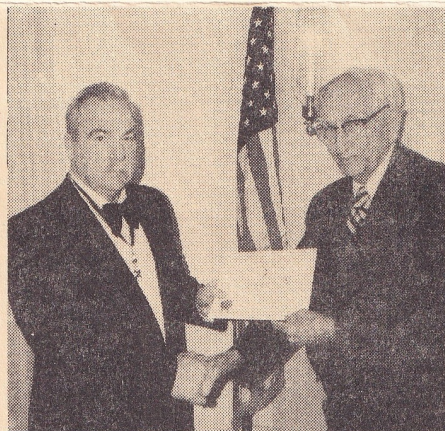
