Kinter and Stroh Slated to Receive SAR Awards

Two past-presidents of the chapter, Herman F. Kinter and LTC Oscar H. Stroh, will be honored by the Pennsylvania Society of SAR, with the presentation of *Silver Good Citizenship Medals*, at the chapter's 52nd Annual Meeting, on December 3, at The Arches Restaurant. They are both being recognized by the State Society for outstanding work in identifying and marking Revolutionary War graves, and for other historical and patriotic community activities.

ANOTHER 50-YEAR MEMBER

Dr. Josiah F. Reed, Jr., of Montgomery, Al., has been awarded an SAR 50-Year Membership Certificate and pin, in recognition of his membership in the chapter since 1942. When he joined at age 18, his father was chapter president.

Dr. Reed has indicated that he hopes to be in Harrisburg on December 3 to receive the award in person. He is a *Life Member* of SAR, and also has the distinction of having as many as 25 Revolutionary ancestors, 13 on his father's side of the family, and 12 on his mother's.

With sorrow we announce two deaths:
Robert W. Long, 74, who died July 17 at Hershey, where he resided in the Rosedale Apartments. He joined Harris Ferry in 1990, by transfer from Reading.
R. Lauck Crawford, 66, a Past-President of Harris Ferry Chapter (1967-68), who died in Harrisburg on October 4.
