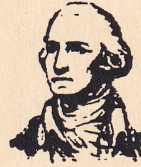

at HAAC, he is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John E. Meehan, of Carlisle.

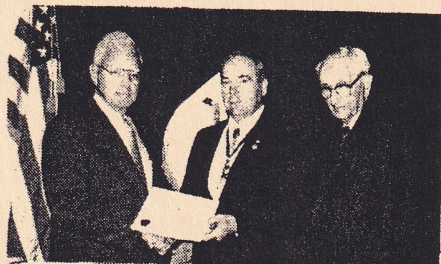
FUTURE MEETINGS & EVENTS

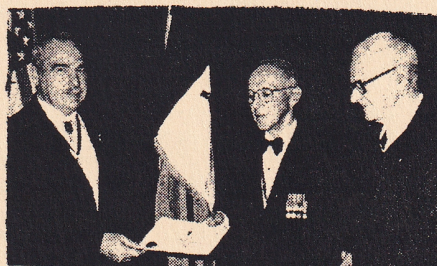
Monday, June 14 -- Chapter's 13-star American Flag to be flown atop State Capitol Building as *Flag Day* observance.
