February Meeting of State SAR Being Hosted by Harris Ferry

Harris Ferry Chapter will be involved in two major meetings here during February -- (1) As host to the quarterly meeting of the Pennsylvania Society of SAR, on February 4-5, at the Penn-Harris Convention Center, Camp Hill, and (2) the Annual DAR-SAR George Washington Dinner, to be held on Sunday, February 20, at the West Shore Country Club.

For the PSSAR Meeting, there will be a reception that Friday evening (Feb. 4) in the Veranda Room of the Penn-Harris, at which a representative of the Pennsylvania State Museum will deliver a slide presentation on "Pennsylvania Capitals -- Three Cities, Three Centuries," the subject of a special exhibit currently being features at the museum.

That Saturday, the morning will be devoted to instructional sessions for SAR member at the convention center, and for the women, a tour of the Pennsylvania State Museum, with transportation to and from the museum provided by chartered "trolley" bus.

The Saturday Luncheon will be held at the Convention Center from 12:30 to 1:30, after which the Quarterly Business Session of PSSAR will be called to order in an adjoining room, and continue until adjournment at about 3:30.

Chapter Presents Certificates To Area's 94 New Eagle Scouts

Harris Ferry Chapter presented SAR Certificates of Recognition to the 94 new Eagle Scouts of the four-county area, at the 19th Annual Eagle Recognition Dinner of the Keystone Area Council, BSA, held on Tuesday, November 23, at the Hershey Motor Inn.

This brought to 967 the total number of such certificates Harris Ferry Chapter has presented to area Eagle Scouts during the 11 years it has participated in the SAR Eagle Scout Scholarship Program.

SAR members attending the November 23 dinner included Past State President Joseph Ramsey, of Duncansville, as chairman of PSSAR's Eagle program; Past Chapter President Herman F. Kinter, and David E. Hartman, as chairman of the chapter's Eagle Scout Committee.

Hartman said that the *local* winner of the Eagle Competition, to be selected here in January, will be honored by the chapter at a February meeting, and will be eligible to compete for the state-wide trophy, and possibly for a national award as well.
