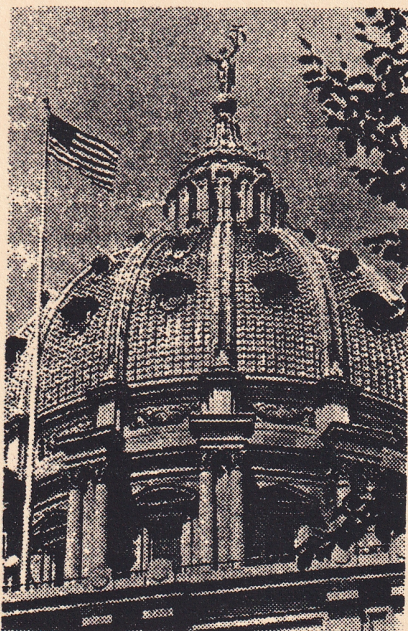

Harris Ferry to Meet Jointly With DAR Chapter



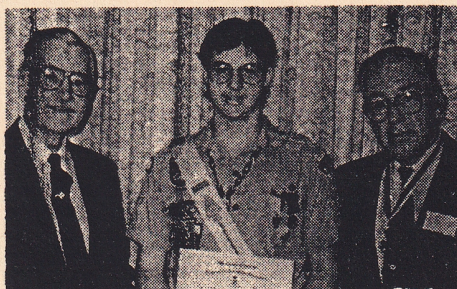
13-STAR FLAG ON CAPITOL

On Tuesday, June 14, the chapter's large 13-star American flag, will again be flown from the main mast atop the Pennsylvania State Capitol, in observance of *Flag Day*. The date this year marks the 217th anniversary of the official adoption of the "Stars & Stripes" as our national ensign by the Continental Congress on June 14,

1777.

In observance of Flag Day, Harris Ferry Chapter will again meet jointly with Harrisburg Chapter of DAR, at a luncheon at 12 Noon on Saturday, June 11, at the West Shore Country Club, Camp Hill.

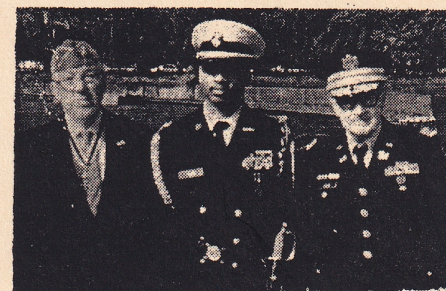
