### CHAPTER TO HONOR 100 EAGLE SCOUTS

SAR Eagle Recognition Certificates will be presented by Harris Ferry Chapter to more than 100 new Eagle Scouts of the four-county Keystone Council Area of BSA on Tuesday, November 22, when the Keystone Council holds its 20th Annual Eagle Recognition Dinner at the Radisson Penn-Harris Hotel, in Camp Hill.

Compatriot David E. Hartman, chapter chairman for the project, noted that this marks the 12th year of our active participation in the Eagle Scholarship program sponsored by SAR nationally.

He said that in the past 11 years, the chapter has awarded such certificates to 967 Eagles of this area, in addition to the 11 SAR Medals given to the area winners.

### STROH TO ADDRESS CHAPTER DINNER

"The Early Iron Furnaces of Dauphin County" will be the topic of LTC Oscar H. Stroh, in addressing the Chapter's quarterly dinner meeting on Friday evening, September 16, at The Arches Restaurant, at 4125 North Front Street, Harrisburg.

Not as old as some of the early furnaces in Cumberland County, which produced iron for the Revolution, Stroh said the ones in Dauphin County did not come into being until the early 1800s.

A past president of Harris Ferry Chapter, Colonel Stroh has the distinction of residing in Fishing Creek Valley on part of the same tract of land originally settled by his ancestor in 1760.
