125 New Eagles Honored

Harris Ferry Chapter presented Eagle Recognition Certificates to the 125 new Eagle Scouts of the four-county Keystone Area of BSA, on November 22, at the 20th Annual Eagle Recognition Dinner of the Keystone Area Council of BSA, at the Radisson Penn-Harris Hotel, Camp Hill.

The 125 scouts also received full details concerning the Eagle Scholarship contest sponsored by SAR nationally. This is the 12th year in which Harris Ferry Chapter has served actively as the area sponsor of the national Eagle Scout competition.

During those years, the chapter has presented SAR Recognition Certificates to as many as 1,092 Eagle Scouts of this area, plus the medals and certificates awarded to the eleven area winners.

SAR Application Fees

Heretofore it had been the rule that annual dues for the first calendar year of SAR membership were *included* in the application fee. Under a recent change of policy, SAR now requires that the \$17 of national dues is to be *added* to the fee for admission.

Accordingly, under Harris Ferry Chapter's fee schedule, Applications for Regular Members (25 or older) now cost \$68 (instead of \$51), and for Junior Members (18 to 25), \$26 (instead of \$9).

Chapter Officers for '95

Chapter Officers for 1995 will be elected on Tuesday evening, December 13, when Harris Ferry holds its 54th Annual Meeting at The Arches Restaurant, at 4125 North Front Street, Harrisburg.

The slate proposed by the Nominating Committee calls for re-election of *most* of the present officers (as listed in column at right) -- except for possible nominations from the floor.

George E. Reed, having asked to be relieved as Secretary, is slated to be succeeded in that capacity by Fred M. Cardene, but has agreed to continue on as Treasurer until 1996.

John A. Pringle is expected to assume the duties of Chaplain, and LTC Oscar H. Stroh will add the title of Genealogist to his present duties as Registrar.
