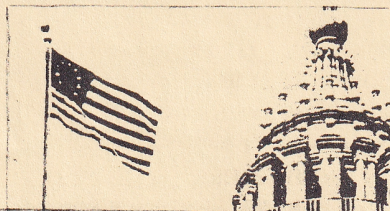

## IN OBSERVANCE OF "FLAG DAY" 1995



ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 14 a 13-star American Flag will again be flown from the main flagpole atop the Pennsylvania State Capitol, in observance of the 218th anniversary of the official adoption of the *Stars and Stripes* as our national ensign by the Continental Congress at Philadelphia on June 14, 1777. The flag is one Harris Ferry Chapter presented to the Commonwealth for such purpose in 1988.

In celebration of Flag Day, Harris Ferry Chapter this year will again meet jointly with the Harrisburg Chapter of DAR, at a luncheon at 12 Noon on Saturday, June 10, at the Harrisburg Country Club, in Fishing Creek Valley, just east of Fort Hunter.

"Thompson's Battalion" and "Flags of the American Revolution" will be the two-part topic of the guest speaker, Mark O. Hagenbuch, Principal of the Northern York Elementary School, at Dillsburg.

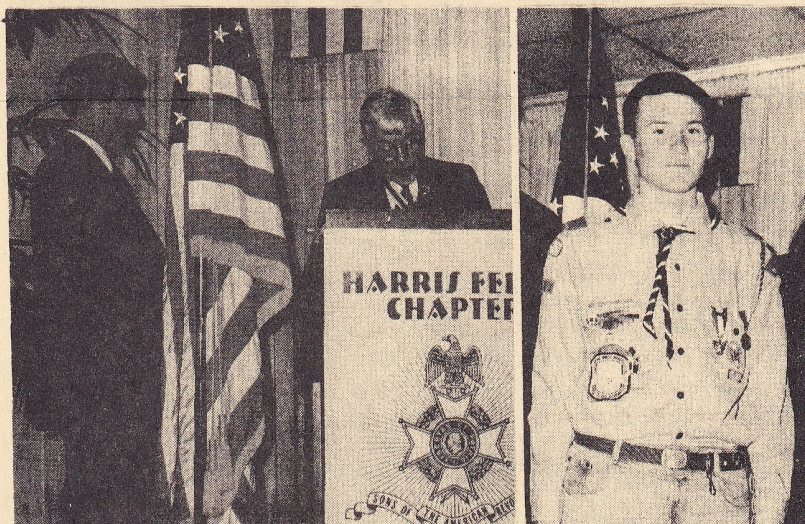
