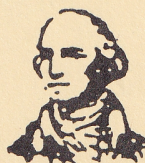

Chapter Honors Winner of Eagle Competition

As local winner of the SAR-sponsored Eagle Contest of 1996, Eagle Scout James



R. Massey, 17, of Camp Hill Troop 51, will be honored by Harris Ferry Chapter at the George Washington Dinner on February 23, when he will receive an SAR Good Citizenship Medal.

David E. Hartman, chairman of the chapter's Eagle Committee, noted that Massey was the adjudged winner in the year's class of 100 new Eagle Scouts within the four counties of the Keystone Area Council of BSA.

As area winner, he is a contender for a statewide trophy being offered by the Pennsylvania Society of SAR, and perhaps for one of the monetary awards offered by SAR nationally.

In Memoriam

With sorrow we announce the passing of Compatriot Quay D. Hamilton, 64, who died on November 18, at his home in Mechanicsburg, less than three months after becoming a member of SAR.

"Washington as a Military Strategist" will be the topic of M/Gen. Gerald T. Sajer, former Adjutant General of Pennsylvania, in addressing the annual DAR-SAR George Washington Dinner, on Sunday, February 23, at the Country Club of Harrisburg.

A native of Milton, PA, Sajer received his secondary education at Girard College, Philadelphia, and in 1956 he was graduated with Phi Beta Kappa honors at Tufts University. He received his law degree from Harvard University in 1959.

General Sajer began his military career as an enlisted man in 1946, and after attending OCS at Ft. Benning, was commissioned a lieutenant in 1947, and served two years in Korea, 1952-53. In 1959, he joined the Pennsylvania National Guard as a captain in the 28th Infantry Division. and after successive promotions became a brigadier general in 1976, and a major general in 1987, upon becoming Pennsylvania's 48th Adjutant General.

Compatriot Evan J. Miller, of Hershey, a charter member of Harris Ferry Chapter and a 70-year Member of SAR, was honored by friends and relatives at a luncheon in celebration of his 100th Birthday, on January 4, at the Hershey Motor Lodge.

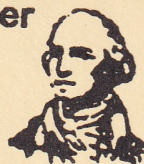
