The Harris Ferry Chapter held an Independence Day commemoration on July 3, 1999 at the State Museum of Pennsylvania in Harrisburg. a representative from the

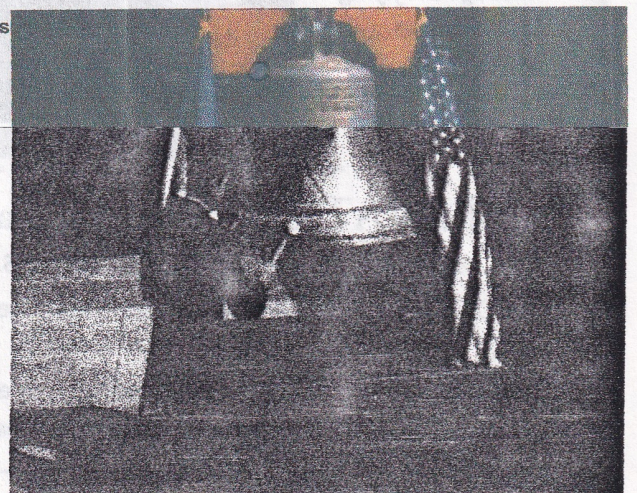
Pennsylvania Adjutant General's office, pictured swings the mallet to start the ceremonial
